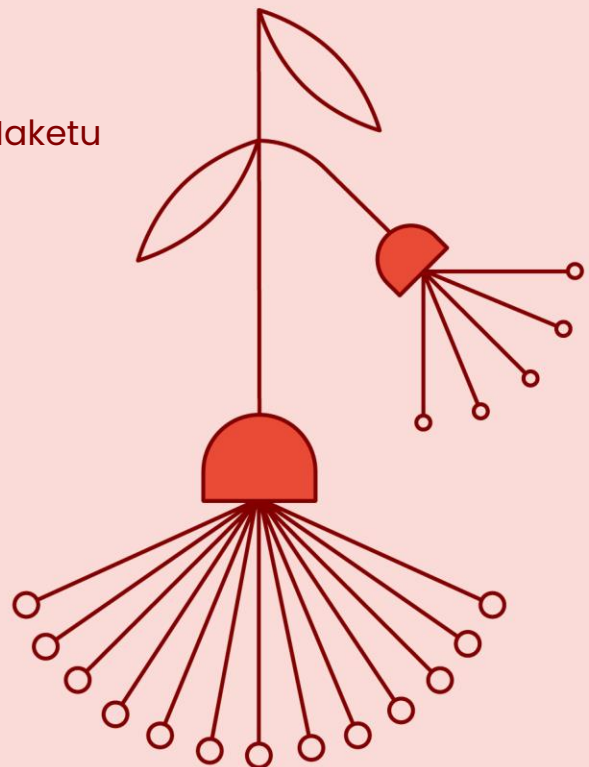

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to enable the Maketu Community Board to make a decision regarding the applications for Community Board Grant Funding, as applied for by Maketu Primary School and Maketu Surf Life Saving Club.

RECOMMENDATION

1. That the Governance Advisor’s report dated 11 June 2024 titled ‘Maketu Community Board – Grant Applications – June 2024’ be received.
2. That the Maketu Community Board **approve** the grant application from Maketu Primary School for \$....., to cover the costs of their Matariki Celebrations. This grant will be funded from the Maketu Community Board Grants Account, subject to all accountabilities being met.

3. That the Maketu Community Board **approve** the grant application from the Maketu Surf Life Saving Club for \$....., to contribute to the costs of a detailed seismic assessment and concrete scanning of the building. BACKGROUND

1. The Maketu Community Board has funding of \$5,000.00 for disbursement to community organisations for the 2023/24 financial year. The balance as of 11 June 2024 is \$4,388.00.
2. **Maketu Primary School** has submitted an application for funding of \$6,750.00 to cover the costs of their Matariki Celebrations.

3. **Maketu Surf Life Saving Club** has submitted an application for funding of \$6,000.00 to contribute to the costs of a detailed seismic assessment and concrete scanning of the building.
