<p>RESOLUTION WB20-6.13</p> <p>Moved: Member B Hulme Seconded: Member D Ryan</p> <p>That the Community Board approve up to \$2,000 from the Roothing Account to mark up the parking bay area behind the 'Village People' store off Wilson Road.</p> <p>April 2021: This MAS has been closed out as it is superseded by MAS WB21-1.12.</p> <p>January 2021: This item was retrospectively discussed with the Board via email.</p> <p>The Roothing Engineer considered the installation of wheel stops to align vehicles rather than paint on stone, which would quickly become scuffed and worn from vehicle movement and people.</p> <p>The estimate received by WestLink indicates that the works would cost approximately \$8,500. A second opinion from another Beach Contractor was similar in price.</p> <p>The works have been awarded to WestLink to complete.</p>
